Bright Stars Youth FC Code of Conduct for Coaches:

- 1. Coaches at BSYFC must uphold the rights, dignity, and value of each individual, treating all players with equality and fairness within the realm of the sport.
- 2. The safety and well-being of every player take precedence over any other consideration, even performance development.
 - 3. Coaches are bound to follow the guidelines stipulated by relevant governing bodies.
- 4. Establishing a foundation of mutual trust and respect, coaches must cultivate a healthy working relationship with each player.
 - 5. Coaches are prohibited from applying undue influence for personal gain or rewards.
 - 6. It's essential for coaches to guide players towards taking ownership of their actions and behavior.
- 7. Activities directed by coaches must align with players' age, maturity, experience, and skill level.
 - 8. At the outset, coaches must transparently communicate expectations from players and what players can expect from their coach, involving parents when necessary.
 - 9. Coaches must collaborate fully with other specialists such as fellow coaches, officials, sports scientists, doctors, and physiotherapists, all in the best interest of the player.
- 10. Promoting the sport's positive aspects, like fair play, is paramount; coaches must not tolerate violations of the Laws of the Game, behavior contrary to the spirit of the Laws, or the use of banned substances or techniques.
- 11. Coaches are expected to consistently display exemplary behavior and maintain a professional appearance.
 - 12. Inappropriate language is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated.

By adhering to these principles, BSYFC coaches contribute to fostering a positive and growthoriented environment for our players.

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
